Cures may include moving the furniture for the most efficient and effective use of the space, guidance on when to and when not to remodel, choosing paint colors for the highest vibration of the room, re-purposing furnishings from one room to another, clarifying energies in artwork and where they will best raise the vibration of the home, specific esoteric Feng Shui cures like crystals may be used to enhance the energy in the space, removing the clutter, getting organized, and finally, balancing the energies of your space with the constructive flow of the five elements – water, wood, fire, earth, metal.

Take Pictures of Your Space











For long distance Zoom clients only, the camera will be my eyes! I ask for pictures (or a video) with at least two angles of each room in the home/office.

One angle should be of the room while you are standing in the door facing into the room. The other angle should be from the opposite direction, standing in the room facing back toward the door. I do not need close ups but a full scope of the room if possible.

I'll also need to see the outside of the house, both the front and back. And pictures from the house into the front and back yards (if applicable).

For local/onsite clients, I will see and be in your space during our in-person session, so no images are needed.
